Some know what to expect and have returned for more uplift, and others are new and curious what 'Your Thought for the Day' will be about. Each day individuals of all backgrounds, ages and cultures take a YTFTD quotes. Hundreds of people each week love to take them.

Here's an example:

Five sporty friends in their 20s each took a YTFTD and they had conversations about them.

A father on vacation read two YTFTD's to his daughters and translated them into Spanish or Portuguese so the girls could understand. Two women in their 40s were taken with the bowl, loudly reading aloud 'Your thought for the Day' sign, then one took a thought for each of them, and she called through our wide open door 'Thank you!' and I replied 'Enjoy!' A man in his 20s with downcast eyes looked as

though his thought had been stirred as he walked passed. He took off his headphones, took a photo of the YTFTD bowl, and took one with him to read. A mother read out her small boy's YTFTD with enthusiasm 'Don't let evil conquer you, but conquer evil by **doing good.**' (Romans 12:21 (NLT) A multi-generational Indian family took thoughts and read them out. A young woman wheeling her bike through the lane took one with a smile. Two trendy teenage girls were interested in getting a YTFTD then one read some of our signage and warned the other not to. Her friend replied, "Sometimes I can be religious" and took one anyway.

### **Coming soon to Concord: search *Science and Health* in four languages**

*Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures* by Mary Baker Eddy will soon be available in French, German, Portuguese, and Spanish within Concord.

You are welcome to add one or more of these languages to an existing Concord account, free of charge at least through 2024 while the language feature is in a beta stage. You can make these updates in the account settings.

This project represents the first time that individuals who are native speakers of one of these languages will be able to digitally search the Christian Science textbook in their own language. A tester of the program who serves as a First Reader in South America commented, "It is a fantastic source for our readings!!"
