Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures by Mary Baker Eddy

1 | 476:4, 9-13

In divine Science, God and the real man are inseparable as divine Principle and idea. God is the Principle of Mortals are man, and man is the idea of God. Hence man is not mortal nor material. Mortals will disappear, and immortals, or the children of God, will appear as the only and eternal verities of man.

2 | 258:21-30

The human capacities are enlarged and perfected in proportion as humanity gains the true conception of man and God.

Mortals have a very Individual permanency imperfect sense of the spiritual man and of the infinite range of his thought. To him belongs eternal Life. Never born and never dying, it were impossible for man, under the government of God in eternal Science, to fall from his high estate.

3 | 151:23-24, 26

The divine Mind that made man maintains His own image and likeness.

All that really exists is the divine Mind and its idea, and in this Mind the entire being is found harmonious and eternal. The straight and narrow way is to see and acknowledge this fact, yield to this power, and follow the leadings of truth.

Step by step will those who Refuge and strength trust Him find that "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble."

ARK. Safety; the idea, or reflection, of Truth, proved to be as immortal as its Principle; the understanding of Spirit, destroying belief in matter.

God and man coexistent and eternal; Science showing that the spiritual realities of all things are created by Him and exist forever.

7 | 530:5-6

In divine Science, man is sustained by God, the divine Principle of being.

8 | 118:26

The definitions of Certain material law, as given by natural science, represent a kingdom necessarily divided against itself, because these definitions portray law as physical, not spiritual. Therefore they contradict the divine decrees and violate the law of Love, in which nature and God are one and the natural order of heaven comes down to earth.

The divine Mind maintains all identities, from a blade of grass to a star, as distinct and eternal.

Christ presents the indestructible man, whom Spirit creates, constitutes, and governs. Christ illustrates that blending with God, his divine Principle, which gives man dominion over all the earth.

If we wish to follow Christ, Truth, it must be in the way of God's appointing.

We must forsake the foundation of material systems, however time-honored, if we would gain the Christ as our only Saviour.

Working and praying with true motives, your Father will open the way. "Who did hinder you, that ye should not obey the truth?"

12 | 269:21

The testimony of the material senses is neither absolute nor divine. I therefore plant myself unreservedly on the teachings of Jesus, of his apostles, of the prophets, and on the testimony of the Science of Mind. Other foundations there are none. All other systems — systems based wholly or partly on knowledge gained through the material senses — are reeds shaken by the wind, not houses built on the rock.

13 | 593:18 (only, to 2nd.)

ROCK. Spiritual foundation; Truth.

14 | 201:7-9

We cannot build safely on false foundations. Truth makes a new creature, in whom old things pass away and "all things are become new."

15 | 285:27

As mortals reach, through salvation knowledge of Christian Science, a higher sense, they will seek to learn, not from matter, but from the divine Principle, God, how to demonstrate the Christ, Truth, as the healing and saving power.

16 | 598:1-5

The Greek word for wind (pneuma) is used also for spirit, as in the passage in John's Gospel, the third chapter, where we read: "The wind [pneuma] bloweth where it listeth. . . . So is every one that is born of the Spirit [pneuma]."

17 | 79:19-20

Jesus did his own work by the one Spirit. He said: "My Father worketh hitherto, and I work."

18 | 191:24-1

The Science of being reveals man and immortality as based on Spirit. Physical sense defines mortal man as based on matter, and from this premise infers the mortality of the body.

The illusive senses may No physical fancy affinities with their opposites;

but in Christian Science, Truth never mingles with error. Mind has no affinity with matter, and therefore Truth is able to cast out the ills of the flesh. Mind, God, sends forth the aroma of Spirit, the atmosphere of intelligence.

19 | 184:27

A woman, whom I cured of consumption, always breathed with great difficulty when the wind was from the east. I sat silently by her side a few moments. Her breath came gently. The inspirations were deep and natural. I then requested her to look at the weather-vane. She looked and saw that it pointed due east. The wind had not changed, but her thought of it had and so her difficulty in breathing had gone. The wind had not produced the difficulty. My metaphysical treatment changed the action of her belief on the lungs, and she never suffered again from east winds, but was restored to health.

20 | 229:28

It is the transgression of a belief of mortal mind, not of a law of matter nor of divine Mind, which causes the belief of sickness. The remedy is Truth, not matter, — the truth that disease is *unreal*.

21 | 411:27-32

Always begin your
treatment by allaying the fear of
patients. Silently reassure them as to their
exemption from disease and danger.

Watch the result of this simple rule of Christian Science, and you will find that it alleviates the symptoms of every disease.

22 | 97:17, 29-32

The more material the belief, the more obvious its error, until divine Spirit, supreme in its domain, dominates all matter, and man is found in the likeness of Spirit, his original being.

Christianity is again demonstrating the Life that is Truth, and the Truth that is Life, by the apostolic work of casting out error and healing the sick.

37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. 38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

This is the doctrine of Christian Science: that divine Love cannot be deprived of its manifestation, or object; that joy cannot be turned into sorrow, for sorrow is not the master of joy; that good can never produce evil; that matter can never produce mind nor life result in death. The perfect man — governed by God, his perfect Principle — is sinless and eternal.

24 | 337:7-10

For true happiness, man must harmonize with his Principle, divine Love; the

Son must be in accord with the Father, in conformity with Christ.

25 | 192:30

Whatever holds human thought in line with unselfed love, receives directly the divine power.

26 | 57:22

Human affection is Help and discipline not poured forth vainly, even though it meet no return. Love enriches the nature, enlarging, purifying, and elevating it. The wintry blasts of earth may uproot the flowers of affection, and scatter them to the winds; but this severance of fleshly ties serves to unite thought more closely to God, for Love supports the struggling heart until it ceases to sigh over the world and begins to unfold its wings for heaven.

27 | 516:12-13, 21

Love, redolent with Love imparts unselfishness, bathes all in beauty and light.

Man and woman as coexistent and eternal with God forever reflect, in glorified quality, the infinite Father-Mother God.

30 | 192:17-21

Moral and spiritual might
belong to Spirit, who holds the
"wind in His fists;" and this teaching accords with Science and harmony. In Science, you can have no power opposed to God, and the physical senses must give up their false testimony.

31 | 288:14

The lightnings and thunderbolts of error may burst and flash till the cloud is

cleared and the tumult dies away in the distance. Then the raindrops of divinity refresh the earth. As St. Paul says: "There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God" (of Spirit).

32 | 506:10-12

Through divine Science, Spirit, God, unites understanding to eternal harmony. The calm and exalted thought or spiritual apprehension is at peace.

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
