We had two visitors this afternoon, one after the other. The first, a man from Manchester, England and the second, a woman from Mexico City. There are a couple of medical conferences in Seattle this week. The first was a research scientist studying alcohol syndrome in young children, and a dedicated Christian. The second was a doctor with some Christian background who believed that healing comes from "the heart" and is not done by a doctor. By "heart" she was referring to Spirit, God. Both are looking for the healing that comes from God and both purchased S&H (English and Spanish versions). They were both given a *March Journal* showing the churches and RRs in their area. When the doctor from Mexico City walked in, she immediately picked up *Science and Health* with both hands and said, "this is what I'm looking for." She'd had a teacher, either in medical school or elsewhere, who had told her of ideas in *Science and Health* and recommended the book. She also purchased the Healing pamphlet and the Prayer for the Big Children in Spanish for her 3-year-old son. She was given a *Herald* and last month's Spanish full text. She's going to look up the Mexico City church and Reading Room when she gets home. So grateful for these earnest and thoughtful conversations and to witness Christ speaking to human consciousness and guiding seekers to our Reading Rooms.

Free Shipping on Reading Room orders and other important announcements

As announced in February, starting on April 1, 2024, all Reading Room orders, placed with standard shipping, will enjoy no shipping fees. This will happen automatically whether you place your Reading Room orders in the Christian Science Online Shop or whether you call or email them in. This universally applies to both domestic and international orders. If you need your order expedited, you will be responsible for shipping fees.

A gentle reminder for Reading Rooms outside of the United States – while we do our best with labeling our shipments, occasionally, they are held in customs and a nominal fee is required to release them. Customs holds do seem to be a little inconsistent, despite consistency with labeling. We're hopeful, though, that the subsidization of shipping fees by The Mother Church helps if your church experiences the need to retrieve a parcel from customs.

Be on the lookout for **two communications coming to your attention**. If you haven't gotten it already, please be on the lookout for a survey asking about your Reading Room activity. Your thoughtful and prayer-filled answers to the questions will help us prioritize the several Reading Room initiatives that are currently underway to support your activity.

- **Log in or create a free account**

You have the option to subscribe at a limited-time discounted annual rate or continue with a free Read-only account. (A Read-only account includes the same features available through Guest Access. No payment method is required, unless you'd like to subscribe.)

If using a free account, Reading Rooms should continue to maintain customers' privacy by ensuring that visitors log out and log back in after each use to clear the search data.

Now available in Concord: search *Science and Health* in four languages

Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures by Mary Baker Eddy is now available in French, German, Portuguese, and Spanish within Concord.

You are welcome to add one or more of these languages to an existing Concord account, free of charge at least through 2024 while the language feature is in a beta stage. You can make these updates in the account settings.

This project represents the first time that individuals who are native speakers of one of these languages will be able to digitally search the Christian Science textbook in their own language. A tester of the program who serves as a First Reader in South America commented, “It is a fantastic source for our readings!!”
