They both stayed for a while then she shared her concerns about her mother who was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis and partner who had epilepsy. I printed off articles of healing for multiple sclerosis, cancer, article called "With drugs and without drugs" and some other articles from JSH-online. I spoke a lot about Jesus' healings and explained that they were not miracles but resulted from his understanding of his relationship to God and God's laws. She was feeling distressed so I started to read the Lord's Prayer from *Science and Health*. She settled and her partner said he was feeling calmer, then went for a walk. I gave her a *Journal* and other literature and explained she could listen to the audio edition of *Science and Health* from Christianscience.com.

Her partner returned and when they were ready to leave he said that he had been diagnosed with lung cancer and they were heading off for the Doctor's appointment now. He said he was feeling much calmer and felt better, then added, "I was diagnosed with cancer but now I know I haven't got it."

They both headed off to the Doctor's office well-armed with the Truth.

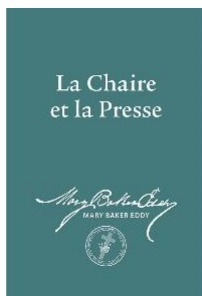

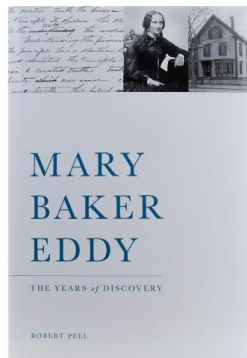
### NEW TRANSLATION: *Pulpit and Press* in French

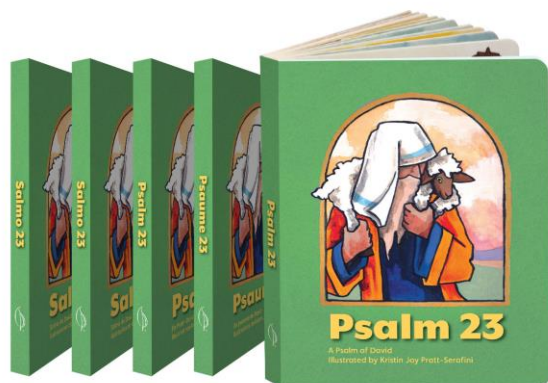
