From the Jointly-Maintained Reading Room in Melbourne, Australia

A young man in his 20s came in with an interest in the gospels. The Assistant Librarian showed him the JB Phillips version, along with the KJV. He is from France and asked if we had a copy in French. Gratefully we did! This was the conversation starter, but it expanded from there.

The Assistant Librarian learned that he grew up as a Muslim, but then he began a spiritual search. He asked many questions along the way and explored various faiths – Buddhism, Hinduism and others, but Christianity resonated the most. He is fairly new to it. The Assistant Librarian drew connections between his search and MBE's, and knowing that asking questions guides his spiritual search, she showed him some of "Recapitulation." He also shared that he didn't like all of the rules in Islam. They spoke about the two greatest commandments being at the heart of Jesus' ministry and central to Christian Science.

She also introduced *Science and Health* to him, and she was glad we had a French copy available. He wasn't sure which book he should purchase. She explained that they are companion books and go hand in hand and invited him to take some time with both before deciding what to purchase. She drew his attention to the chapter on Prayer. He read several pages of it and then decided to buy both books. She also shared about the other offerings of Christian Science – church services and testimony meetings, practitioners, the magazines (she showed him the online version of the French Herald). She showed him the back of the Journal where he can find churches and practitioners, both here in Australia and in France. They had a very warm, heartfelt and meaningful exchange as seekers. He left with a French Bible and *Science and Health*, along with a free copy of the *Journal* and *Sentinel*. Grateful for this exchange – Truth is indeed universal.



NEW: Christian Science: Continuing Evidence of Christ-Healing





NEW: Sterling Student Edition of Science and Health





The 2026 Annual Meeting of The Mother Church will be held on Monday, June 8, 2026, in accordance with the *Manual of The Mother Church* by Mary Baker Eddy. You are warmly invited to attend in person or online. The event schedule includes:

- **Sunday, June 7**—Church services (10 a.m. & 5 p.m.) and hymn sing
- **Monday, June 8**—Annual Meeting

Activities will not be offered on Friday or Saturday this year. **Registration will open in early 2026.**

Please note: The FIFA World Cup will take place in Boston beginning June 11, 2026. FIFA organizers tell us that this event will impact domestic and international travel, hotel availability, and local public transportation. We recommend planning your travel with this in mind.
